Supporting Learning & Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To work specifically with children with special educational needs under the direction of the SENDCo• Support pre-planned learning/behaviour activities as directed• Using agreed structured observation as directed by the class teacher to feedback on learning, behaviour, participation and achievement, to support the planning and evaluation of the learning process in respect of groups and individual students• Interact with students in ways that support the development of their ability to think and learn, including the use of careful questioning• Assist teachers in the implementation of appropriate behaviour management and teaching & learning strategies• Support students in their social and emotional wellbeing, in implementing related programmes, including social, health and physical needs• Assist in escorting and supervising students on educational visits and out of school activities• Undertake break supervision as required
